Please read the following information concerning your petition packet:

1. NOMINATING PETITION:

In order to become a candidate for the office of member of the Board of Education, you must meet the qualifications set forth on the enclosed Nominating Petition. The Petition must have a minimum of twenty-five (25) signatures and must be returned to my office at East Rochester Union Free School District, 222 Woodbine Avenue, East Rochester, NY 14445, on or before 4:00 P.M. on Monday, April 20, 2020. A qualified voter is any individual who is a citizen of the United States, 18 years of age or older, and a resident of the District for at least 30 days prior to the date of the election.

2. CANDIDATE CERTIFICATION STATEMENT:

Each candidate must certify that they meet the qualifications and have received the appropriate information in the candidate packet.

3. EXPENDITURE STATEMENT (3):

Each candidate for the position of member of the Board of Education whose expenses and/or contributions received exceed \$500 must file a statement accounting for campaign expenditures and contributions with the District Clerk and an additional statement with the Commissioner of Education. In the event the expenses do not exceed \$500 and the aggregate amount of all contributions made to the candidate do not exceed \$500, then a sworn statement to that effect need only be filed with the District Clerk.

Expenditure Statements must be filed as follows:

- A. The first statement shall be filed on or before the thirtieth (30th) day preceding the election which is on or before 4:00 P.M. Monday, April 20, 2020.
- B. A second statement shall be filed on or before the fifth (5th) day preceding the election which is on or before 4:00 P.M. <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>May 14, 2020</u>.
- C. A third statement shall be filed within twenty (20) days after the election, which is on or before 4:00 P.M. Monday, June 8, 2020.



D. Any contributions or loans in excess of \$1,000, if received after the close of the period covered in the last statement filed before the election, but before the election itself, shall be reported within twenty-four (24) hours after receipt.

4. BIOGRAPHICAL FORM:

Please fill out and return with your completed petition by Monday, April 20, 2020.

6. BOARD VACANCIES:

Vacancies on the Board of Education are not to be considered separate offices. Therefore, the enclosed Nominating Petition does not describe a specific vacancy for which a candidate is nominated. The candidate receiving a plurality of the votes cast will be elected. The Education Law provides that when candidates are not nominated for a specific vacancy, the names of the candidates shall be listed on the ballot in the order determined by a lottery drawing. The drawing will be held in the Business Office at 222 Woodbine Avenue, on Tuesday, April 21, 2020, at 9:00 A.M. In the event that you are not present in person or represented by a person designated as proxy, the Clerk will act as your proxy.

7. BOARD ELECTION:

The annual election will be held on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>May 19</u>, <u>2020</u>, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 9:00 P.M. The District Budget Hearing to discuss the budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, will begin at 7:00 P.M. on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>May 5, 2020</u>, in the District Conference Room.

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East Rochester Union Free School District Information on Candidate Expenditure Statements



All candidates for election to the Board of Education must file sworn statements with the Clerk of the District, and, in some cases, with the Commissioner of Education, relating to monies or other valuable things paid, given, promised or expanded by the candidate and by others with the candidate's approval. Such expenditures must be related to the candidate's nomination or election.

Certain expenditures are considered by law to be "personal expenses." They are expenses incurred and paid directly and personally by the candidate and include, for example, travel expenses, printing, stationery, postage, and telegraph or telephone charges.

The statements must be filed with the Clerk of the District. If the total of personal expenses and expenditures by others with the candidate's approval is more than \$500, the statements must also be filed with the Commissioner of Education.

There are three required filing dates. The first statement must be filed thirty (30) days before the date of the election, (April 20, 2020) and the second statement must be filed five (5) days before the date of the election, (May 14, 2020) the third statement must be filed within twenty (20) days after the election (June 8, 2020). All of these statements must cover the period up to and including the day prior to filing.

If the total expenditure is more than \$500, the statement must be itemized and the contributors must be identified. When an itemized statement is filed, subsequent statements need only summarize the expenditures previously reported.

Any expenditure made on behalf of a candidate without the candidate's approval shall be limited to \$25, and shall not be included in computing the \$500 limitation referred to above. In addition, the person making the expenditure must file a sworn statement with the Clerk of the District and the Commissioner of Education stating that the candidate did not approve such expenditures.

If a candidate does not file the required statements, any other candidate or any five qualified voters of the District may institute an action in Supreme Court, Monroe County, to compel the required filings.

Promoting candidacy to become a Board member is allowed under New York State Education Law; however certain parameters should be followed by all candidates to assure fair and equal access to the voting public. To that end, legal counsel has advised candidates to avoid the following:

- a. Having school district personnel, such as teachers, send home with students any partisan materials (even if students are given materials in envelopes or packages and simply told to provide them to their parents); this also applies even if the partisan materials are supplied by a PTA or other organization or entity;
- b. Providing any person or entity, including a PTA-type organization, with mailing labels to be used for partisan purposes;
- c. Letting a candidate or other person or entity use the school district's copying resources or materials or bulk mail permit for partisan purposes;
- d. Providing a candidate or other person or entity with access to the school district's "established channels of communication" for partisan purposes;
- e. Permitting a candidate or other person or entity to send email over school district computers for partisan purposes;
- f. Allowing a candidate or other person or individual appearing at a school district function, such as a class, convocation, field trip, parents' night, extracurricular activity, assembly, etc. to make communications for partisan purposes such as seeking support for or against election to the Board or for or against the budget or for or against any other proposition.

Concerning Campaign Contributions:

Each candidate receiving more than \$500 in campaign contributions must file a statement accounting for his/her expenditures and contributions with the District Clerk's office. Please refer to Newly Adopted District Policy 1220 Reporting Expenditures and Contributions for complete details.

*If you are interested in putting up signs in the Village of East Rochester you must call the ER Code Enforcement Office at 385-3513 and obtain a permit and pay a fee. Signs in Pittsford and Perinton may be erected 90 days prior to an election, no larger than 6 feet by 6 feet, no closer than 10 feet from a lot line, not placed in the right of way and must be removed within 7 days of the election.
