WORK EXPERIENCE

- List any work experience during the last two years.

ESSAY

- Provide an example or story of how you help or have helped your community thrive and prosper.
- Your community could mean your neighborhood, your family, your school, your place of worship, your group of friends etc.
- One page only, double spaced, typed, 11-pt. font.

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

- One letter from a school official, coach or community/volunteer organization where you volunteered.
- Clearly illustrates their support for the student to receive this scholarship.
- No more than one page.
